Game Time - 12:00 p.m.

The game begins at 12:00 p.m. Please arrive up to 30 minutes early to allow for heavy foot traffic and bag checks at the entrance. Once inside Goodman Stadium, spectators will not be permitted to leave and re-enter (including halftime). Spectators will not be allowed into Goodman Stadium after halftime. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted inside Goodman Stadium. Visibly intoxicated persons will not be permitted to enter the stadium. All spectators will be screened at the entrance (bags larger than 12" x 12" x 10" are not permitted in the Stadium). The University's alcohol policy and PA State law are enforced on and around the campus.

Sportsmanship -

Lehigh fans are asked to cheer FOR LEHIGH ("Let's go Lehigh! And "Beat Lafayette") and not against the opponent. Being loud in support of our team helps us; being abusive towards the other team does not. The Patriot League institutions have made a commitment to ensure that their athletic programs promote and require the highest standards of sporting behavior and ethical conduct by all participants (student-athletes, coaches, staff and faculty). Additionally, Lehigh University demands the highest standards from all supporters (students, alumni, other spectators, bands, cheerleaders, spirit groups).

Tickets / TV / Radio -

Tickets are still available for the game. Get yours ASAP at LehighTickets.com. All students need a ticket to enter the game. Students: take a photo of your tickets in case there are wifi or cellular issues at the stadium. The photo of your ticket will have the ticket barcode, and that can be scanned for admission to Goodman Stadium. Check LehighSports.com and @LehighSports for additional information. This game will be live on Fox Sports Radio 1230 AM and 94.7 FM and streamed on ESPN+.

Behavior and Consequences -

Prior to the game, students are expected to follow tailgating policies and procedures. Any student who behaves in a disruptive manner will face criminal and University consequences which may include arrest and immediate suspension from the University.

Stay Off the Field of Play -

Spectators are not permitted to enter the playing field at any time. Entering the field of play before or during the game may result in disciplinary action being taken by the University.

<u>Game day:</u> Buses will run continuously to bring students from Asa Packer Campus over to Goodman Stadium beginning at 9:00 a.m. All buses will load and depart from Taylor Street in front of the Dialogue Center. **A ticket to the game is required to board the bus.**

The Campus Connector will not operate between 9:00 a.m.. – 4:30 p.m. on Goodman Campus.

All Ride Share drop offs and pick-ups are located at the flag poles in front of Stabler Arena. No Ride Share vehicles are permitted on Stadium Road which runs to the front gates of Goodman Stadium.
